

Corrigendum/Explanation SFG 2024 Level 1 Test 21

There are no changes to the solutions/answers. Some explanations have been provided for the students who have raised doubts.

Q.15) There was a doubt raised with respect to Option 3 of the Question i.e. Separation of Burma from India occurred during the Viceroyship of Lord Linlithgow.

Explanation: Burma formally split from India on April 1, 1937. Lord Linlithgow was Viceroy of India from 1936 to 1944. So, it is true that separation of Burma from India occurred during the Viceroyship of Lord Linlithgow.

Q.18) There was a doubt raised with respect to Statement 2 of the Question: “While the Muslim League endorsed the two-nation theory, the Hindu Mahasabha proposed the integration of Muslim population into a united India.”

Explanation: The Hindu Mahasabha did not endorse the two-nation theory. The Hindu Mahasabha was vehemently opposed to the proposals for creating new Muslim-majority provinces and reservation of seats for Muslims majorities in Punjab and Bengal. It also demanded a strictly unitary structure.

Although, there are arguments that Hindu Mahasabha also proposed two nation theory, but we cannot authenticate from any authentic source which says the same. Hence, the statement is considered as correct.
