

## Corrigendum/Explanation SFG 2024 Level 1 Test 22

There are no changes to the solutions/answers. Some explanations have been provided for the students who have raised doubts.

Q.9) There was a doubt raised with respect to Statement 2 of the Question i.e. "Punjab Hindu Sabha vehemently opposed the partition of India based on religious lines."

Explanation: It is true that the Punjab Hindu Sabha opposed the Congress for trying to unite Indians of all colours into a single nation. They argued that Hindus should side with the colonial government in their fight against Muslims (as written in Spectrum). But this does not mean that they were in favour of partition of India based on religious lines. None of the authentic sources mention that the Punjab Hindu Sabha supported the partition of India. There are some editorials which mentions rise of communalism in India due to the activities of Hindu Mahasabha or its associated groups, but this does not mean they were in favour of partition of India based on religious lines. Thus, the statement remains correct.
