Before the borders are broken, the
minds are invaded

In a small obscure village in the
state of Manipur, lived a girl. Being a
tribal, in a state of poverty all around
there was not much she had to look up to.
But despite the lack of square meals,
sports institutions or fancy equipment,
she had a mind that was invaded.
Invaded by the imagination of repre-
senting India at global stage. Imagi-
nation to be a sports woman. Regularly
practising under the abysses of the dense
~~for~~ forests with logs of wood, the
lady went on to be India's First
woman to win silver medal at
olympics heavy weight lifting.

The girl was able to do
it because the borders set in front
of her had fallen down in face
of the invasion of her mind by an
idea.

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The girl is Meerabai Channu. Similar stories come from several athletes' life like MS Dhoni, Sachin Tendulkar, Mary Kom etc. All of them had several borders that seemed unanthomable to cross.

But what made them jump past them, break them was the power of mind. The invasion of the mind by an imagination of the world beyond the borders!

In this essay we will explore what are these 'borders'? who sets them? why invasion of mind is important? what happens when mind is invaded? and How can we enable it? and lastly do all minds after invasion, break borders? and are all invasion good?

Borders: What are they?

'Borders' are the limitations which are set to the full expression of human mind. As Socrates said, 'Ignorance or lack of knowledge is the root cause of immorality'. To him the lack of knowledge restricted one to the limitations set by one's borders.

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these borders then, become barriers
which do not allow us to see beyond.
the book 'The Hunger Games' perfectly
reflects on this. Here young people
are chosen to fight and kill each
other for mass entertainment. It is
only when Katherine (lead actor)
realises the absurdity of the game
(her mind invaded) that a revolution
is sparked. (borders broken).

The question now comes →

[Who sets these borders]

these borders are set by varied
influences that a person has. They can
be set by the culture, society, polity,
economy or by the person himself.
Exploring each of them is worthwhile.

Culturally, these barriers
are commanded by religion or
stereotypes. these set commandments
restrict full expression of mind.

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Take instance of restriction on female education during ancient times. It was a formidable border to cross. However, likes of spala, Gargi, appaz who set beautiful works of literature in course of history, show the power of mind's invasion.

In terms of society, race for example, becomes a barrier to many. It was Rosa Parks and her 'No!' to the command of leaving the front seat of a bus, that showed defiance. This defiance came from a mind that was invaded by ideas of freedom, equal civil rights. Ultimately leading to Black emancipation.

Economically & politically too these borders exist. Pierre Bourdieu, a sociologist, suggests that there are certain capitals, and an unequal access to these result in inequality. These capitals are ideological, social, economic etc. For instance, poverty can be a border (economic capital)

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to full realization of human mind.
But it can be overcome if one has
a mind of vision (invaded by idea).
Evidences of Narayan murthy
(INFOSYS), JRD Tata are few. These
men had very little in their hands
to call money to invest but had a
vision and this vision led to breaking
of borders.

The fall of USSR, Berlin
wall was an expression of political
barriers being broken by invasion
of mind. Realising the contrast
between East and West of Berlin
wall, the border was broken quite
literally! French revolution
was also a result of mind being
invaded by ideas set forth by Rousseau,
Montesquieu which broke the border
of serfdom (feudalism).

Question now is,

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Why invasion of mind is important?

The answer lies in the fact that, it
is only through the mind that one
can see beyond what meets the eye.
This power of mind is beautifully
captured by ^{Mannah Argent} ~~argentina~~ who says,
a totalitarian regime survives only
because it can control the mind. ~~because~~
That way, it sets boundaries that are
made to seem unbreakable because
of the limitations of the mind.

What happens when the mind is invaded?

When the mind undergoes invasion,
the invasion of ideas - imagination,
it becomes invincible! Because if
there are no boundaries set forth, there
are no limitations that can prevent
a person's full expression. Fredrich
Nietzsche believed, a man can be
'superman' (Uebermensch) i.e.
german
invincible if he has moved beyond

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the limits of the mind. Amartya
Sen's capability approach to
tackle poverty is also based on same
idea of breaking mind's barriers, thus
allowing full human expressions.
Buddha, Mahavir became what they
were by conquering over the mind.
How to enable invasion of mind?

a simple tool to enable
mind's invasion lies in Socrates
simple rule of accepting
"I know nothing".

Because, when the mind is ready to
learn and is receptive to change
it can automatically allow invasion
of ideas. Kalidas, the famous
novelist of India moved from
den of ignorance to literary extremes
by mind invasion. When he

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allowed his mind to undertake the
vigorous course of learning, the invasion
was set forth. What came out was
author of greatest literary achievements
like Shakuntala, Meghadoot etc.

By questioning stereotypes, every
mundane experience along with the
ability to learn, one can facilitate
mind's invasion.

A question now comes,

Are all invasions good? and do all
borders break on mind's invasion?

The invasion of mind is
subject to the substance it is invaded
with. If ideas of nihilism, false
sense of superiority invade the mind,
holocaust of men follows (Jews
by Nazi Germany). Similarly
mind invasion can be also used to
prevent one from actually breaking
barriers!

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Noam Chomsky in his book 'manufacturing consent' speaks how media is used to generate an image in the mind of the people. By invading the mind, it restricts its freedom of thought. This leads to Borders getting reinforced. Take instance of rising consumer culture. Even on knowing the ill effects of it one is unable to break the borders. Reason is counter invasion by capitalism prevents one's freedom of thought.

Similarly, in book 'Surveillance Capitalism' a case has been made as to how a man's actions online are monitored to reinforce the same behaviour. The algorithm does precisely that. For instance, if one searches for a racist post on

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social media, despite the ill bearings of the same, the behaviour is reinforced by the algorithm. Thus, invading the mind negatively and erecting more borders.

Lastly, despite the case made on both fronts the power of invasion of mind cannot be ignored. It is the start of a revolution. As often said, "Everything great starts with an idea"

Hence, without this idea or imagination our limits cannot be crossed.

"An elephant in chains
kept the same form the day
being ~~born~~ born,
lacks the power to cross
the borders
because of mind's conviction
has only himself to

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Doubt is the origin of wisdom

It was a time when the church was an upholder of social order, decided the rules of society. One of its teachings was 'the earth is the center of the universe and everything else revolves around it'. This idea just did not sit well with a man. He experimented and found a counter view, that the 'sun' instead was the center of the universe. His experiment was born out of his ability to 'doubt'. The man was Copernicus.

Copernicus's story is the story of science. It is so because, the story of science is the story of doubt. Copernicus stopped at earth being a peripheral item to the sun at center. This journey of doubt led to birth of gravitation by Newton. Countering it came Quantum mechanics of the contemporary times.

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what all this show is that it was only because of putting a doubt on an established principle, that the wisdom of new information came forth.

in this way we will explore what doubt is? how it leads to wisdom? how to generate doubt? why some of us lack the power of doubt? and lastly does doubt always lead to wisdom?

Doubt: meaning and beyond

Doubt is the ability to question. this questioning rests on the principle of seeing everything with an inquiring eye. [Socrates] roamed the streets of Athens asking people the most mundane questions. He doubted everything. for him, it was by questioning everything that one can attain wisdom. He thus

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gave birth to the 'dialectic method of enquiry' which essentially means doubting everything.

Philosophically, this journey of doubt got so established that various schools generated. For instance ethics of teleology i.e. consequences as a moral bar of action (J.S. Mill, Jeremy Bentham) was doubted by Kant. Kant gave his idea of duty as sole compass of morality above of consequences. This wisdom was generated by doubt.

How doubt leads to wisdom?

When a person becomes ready to doubt, he becomes ready to find alternatives. And this journey of alternatives leads to wisdom. Raja Ram Mohan Roy doubted the ritual of Sati on basis of humanity, rationality. What followed was 1829 act regulating Sati. (wisdom). Similarly, B.R. Ambedkar questioned and doubted

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the set order, of varna and caste system. this doubt led to emancipation of caste. the constitution of India is an evidence of this 'modern man' doubting 'manu' of the old.

Hence, only when a doubt is sparked in the mind can other attributes of finding solution follow. question now is,

how to generate doubt? why some lack it?

to generate doubt one needs to have the freedom of thought? No great bearing has ever come by following the set convictions. only when the mind is free of fetters can it question. when Descartes gave
(Cogito ergo sum)
(I think therefore I am)

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he reasoned on the same agency of
thought which is the mother of doubt
and cause and consequence of
wisdom.

Take instance of Nazi Germany,
the Führer (Adolf Hitler) gave the
order to gas millions of Jews. Here
people like A. Eichmann who were
responsible for sending people to
Auschwitz (concentration camp) lacked
exactly the power of doubt. Whereas
Oscar Schindler in the same Germany
saved millions thousands of Jews
because of his power to doubt and
reason. Hannah Arendt in her

'Banality of Evil' says exactly this.
That the most evil tasks are performed
by those who lack the power of doubt
or reason. Those who only follow
the rules without application of
the mind.

This presents to us why
some lack the power of doubt.

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It is because for them the set order of the world is supreme. Doubting it can bring discomfort. The arduous journey it is, to generate doubt, live with it, and actively seek answers is uncomfortably avoided by many.

Technology has amplified this passiveness and subdued the agency of doubt. By echochambers such as reddit, stereotypes get reinforced. Rise of right wing in politics advocating for white supremacy in USA, for instance are a result of ability to doubt getting damped by technology. blashtags are used to generate opinions and affect mass psychosis by running false narratives.

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But there can be several other barriers
to wisdom, it can be that even in
face of doubt one lacks wisdom.

Doubt but no wisdom ! Barriers

Take instance of an entrepreneur
he doubts the present model of
governance present in the social
media world. Now even in face of doubt
if he lacks the resources to fulfil his
wisdom, the journey cannot be completed
So to say, One may wish to regulate old
clothes being dumped in deserts (Atacama
desert) by refurbishing them but
he cannot if he lacks economic power
in form of venture capitalist or angel
investors.

Similarly, political power
existing in a society can become a
barrier to wisdom even in face of
doubt. For instance, a gig worker
facing mass layoff, drastic pay
~~cuts~~ effectively doubts the
cuts

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organisation and the rules governing it. But in face of lack of trade unions, his fails to get his demand articulated. case of somato gig worker is precisely this.

In the same vein, social barriers can prevent the realization of wisdom even if doubt exists. For long, untouchables followed the varna system of the vedas even in face of doubt because they lacked the access to knowledge. It was only when knowledge itself became accessible that these barriers crumbled.

therefore, doubt in itself is not enough. what is more important is to utilize that doubt and search for alternatives. seek resources to realise wisdom.

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Doubt and wisdom : a way forward

In her book Silent Spring, Rachael Carson expressed doubts on the use of certain chemicals that she believed were harming the environment. What followed was an era of environmental wisdom.

What the above example along with others show is that, without doubt one cannot expect a new world order, and in absence of doubt one goes against the Laws of Nature. As Darwin proposed in his Theory of evolution that 'change to the law of nature'. Evolution is the evidence of doubt casted on organisms by nature itself. Similarly, if one decides not to doubt, he is refusing the 'change as an order of Law'.

When doubt comes, second step is not to conform it but to raise it to the highest level of

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human enquiry. Mahatma Gandhi
doubted the British intentions and
their supreme authority. It was
only by giving ~~to~~ his every breath
to avaraj, to this 'doubt' in his
mind that freedom was won.

"To free the mind and
encapsulate wisdom, doubt is
the genesis."
