**Explanation:** Statement 1 of question 50 is incorrect. The Lima Work Programme on Gender was initiated at the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) – Conference of Parties (COP20) in 2014. **At COP 25 in 2019, Conference of Parties agreed a 5-year enhanced Lima work programme on gender and its gender action plan.** Following the process for the final review , at COP 29 Parties concluded the review of the enhanced Lima work programme on gender and extended it for 10 years. So, **the enhanced Lima Work Programme was launched in 2019 at UNFCCC COP 25** and further extended in UNFCCC COP 29 (2024) for 10 years.
