Explanation: Statement 1 of question 50 is incorrect. The Lima Work Programme on Gender was initiated at the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) – Conference of Parties (COP20) in 2014. At COP 25 in 2019, Conference of Parties agreed a 5-year enhanced Lima work programme on gender and its gender action plan. Following the process for the final review , at COP 29 Parties concluded the review of the enhanced Lima work programme on gender and extended it for 10 years. So, the enhanced Lima Work Programme was launched in 2019 at UNFCCC COP 25 and further extended in UNFCCC COP 29 (2024) for 10 years.

It instead **works to advance gender balance and integrate gender considerations** into the work of Parties and the secretariat **in implementing the Convention and the Paris Agreement** so as to achieve gender-responsive climate policy and action.
