

### Updated Corrigendum/Explanation SFG 2025 Level 1 Test 30

**In Q.3)** There was a doubt regarding pair 3 of the question that Point bars are found on the **concave or convex** side of meanders of large rivers?

**Explanation)** **Pair 3 of the question is incorrectly matched.** Point bars are sediments deposited in a linear fashion by flowing waters along the river bank and are found on the convex side of meanders of large rivers. All the standard sources including Savinder Singh's Book and egyankosh etc. mention the same information.

The confusion is because NCERT has incorrectly interpreted point bars in Chapter 6 of Class XI Physical Geography Book. But the NCERT in the Teachers Training Module of the same chapter provides the correct information (source is attached below.)

Note: Also the faculty in the next discussion of the upcoming SFG test i.e. Test 32 will again take up the topic. Kindly refer the same for better understanding.
