There are no changes to the solutions/answers. Explanations have been provided for the students who have raised doubts.

In Q.18) A doubt was raised whether Lake Titicaca is the highest navigable lake in the world.

Explanation- Lake Titicaca is the highest navigable lake in the world. As per various sources, it is known as the highest navigable lake in the world, it sits at an elevation of about 3,812 meters (12,507 feet) above sea level.

Gurudongmar Lake is one of the highest lakes in the world and in India, located at an altitude of 17,800 ft (5,430 m), in the Indian state of Sikkim. There are other lakes as well which are at a higher elevation than Gurudongmar Lake as well as Lake Titicaca like Lake Licancbur which is a high Andean lake at an altitude of 19,410 feet (5,916 meters). But these are not navigable lakes. The highest navigable lake in the world is Lake Titicaca.
