

Results for FRC - Phase 2

1. Based on the entrance test performance, AWFG and MGP Test attendance and scores, all candidates part of Phase 1 have been allocated into 4 groups. They have been allocated in FRC 8,9,10. Candidates in Group 4 have not been allocated any FRC Cohort.
2. We have observed that while some students have been able to maintain their consistency, and bring out the best in them, some students have been finding it difficult to put adequate effort. We have also seen that some students are only benefitting from making friends and the long walks that the campus is able to offer.
3. Candidates in Group 1 - Top 40 are expected to maintain their consistency and stick to the program guidelines in Phase 2, given that prelims does remain a crucial bottleneck in preparation for 99% of people. We recommend no laxity in the Prelims phase from you, especially for anyone who has not cleared prelims twice. Anyone with even 1 prelim success has a fragile prelim and no amount of mains effort can compensate for that.
4. All candidates have been allocated a future Cohort of 8, 9, or 10 except Group 4 students.
5. Candidates who have landed in Group 4 have not been allocated any FRC Batch, and we feel that they may not benefit from FRC programs in future which demand more commitment than they have shown. It is advised that they can explore ForumIAS Academy online programs from the comfort of their homes. **To make it easy for them to make this decision, SFG Level 1 and Prelims Sprint classes will be provided to them at Rs. 0 in the online mode.** While no one is being forcefully expelled from the campus, we would like candidates placed in Group 4 to introspect as to what could be the reason for their inability to stick to ONE program.
6. Please note that selections in competitive exams do not happen because of the best plan, best teachers, best notes, best coaching. They happen because a student is able to bring out the best in her in that short period of time. We feel that candidates in Group 3 & Group 4 are yet to bring out the best in them.
7. Remember, our life's ranklist changes every 7 years. This is just about a few weeks. Irrespective of your current group allocation or performance, each one of you is capable of massively changing your fate in the coming weeks - both positively and negatively. We have witnessed students rise from ashes like a phoenix and do well from this list. And we will witness students performing at the top, jeopardising their own success, by quitting doing what made them do well in the first place. This is an appeal to each one of you doing well, we see hope in you. History will not repeat itself, if you do not let it - but it will all depend on you.
8. The coming months will be most crucial for all of you - for it will be the culmination your entire life's academic efforts - every time you did well in school, every essay that you wrote in school, every time you got a 9/10 in any test at school, college or even in Civils preparation - it was for this - the Civil Services Examination - the terminal examination of your career. And the Prelims is its passport.
9. While candidates allocated to Group 4 and some in Group 3 need to work on efforts, not on their caliber or potential - and will need more sincerity towards the examination, those in Group 1 and Group 2 must not get complacent - not one bit. Because it doesn't take long in life for tables to turn. Remember, success is never *owned*, it is *rented* and the rent is overdue *everyday*.
10. Mains appeared candidates who joined late may overlook the groupings given that current grouping marks candidates who did not appear for bygone tests as absent, but must remain cautious for the future.
11. Candidates not allocated any cohort may speak to Nitin Sir [Roll Numbers ending with 0,1,2,3] & Kanishk Sir [Roll Numbers ending with 4,5,6] & Sindhu Sir [Roll Numbers ending with 7,8,9] and explain the reason behind their inability to do their best.
12. If you keep doing what you have been doing, you will keep getting what you have gotten.
