Exp) Option c is the correct answer.

Option I is correct: Egypt has access to the Red Sea with its vast land border with Red Sea.

Options II and III are correct: Saudi Arabia borders the Red Sea along its western coast, stretching almost the entire length. Yemen shares a southern coastal border with the Red Sea.

Option IV is incorrect: Oman is located on the southeastern coast of the Arabian Peninsula and does not share any land border with the Red Sea.
