I. He shifted the capital of the Delhi Sultanate from Lahore to Delhi.

II. He introduced the Charai tax.

III. He imposed Jizya on non-Muslims for the first time during the Delhi Sultanate period.

Which of the statements given above is/are correct?

a) I only

b) II and III only

c) I and II only

d) None of the above

Exp) Option a is the correct answer.

Statement I is correct. Iltutmish **shifted the capital from Lahore to Delhi**, recognising Delhi's strategic location for controlling North India. This move firmly established Delhi as the political centre of the Sultanate.

Statement II is incorrect. The **Charai tax**, imposed on **pasture land for grazing animals**, was introduced later by **Alauddin Khalji**, not by Iltutmish.

Statement III is incorrect. **Jizya** was first imposed on non-Muslims by **Qutbuddin Aibak**, where it was referred to as **kharaj-o-jizya**.
