There is 1 change in today's paper. In Q.35 the correct answer is Option b

Q.35) A doubt was raised whether Sabhasaar is an AI-powered tool for recording the proceedings of Gram Sabhas as well.

Exp) Sabhasaar feature does not include recording the proceedings of the meeting; rather, Sabha's meetings audio/video recordings are uploaded in Sabhasaar in a standardized format. Sabhasaar AI would work on the recordings uploaded - there would be automatic transcription, multilingual translation using Bhashini, and understanding the meeting context.

Q.35) With reference to 'SabhaSaar', an initiative recently launched by the Government, consider the following statements:

- I. It is an AI-powered tool for recording and summarising the proceedings of Gram Sabhas.
- II. It was launched by the Union Ministry of Panchayati Raj.

Which of the statements given above is/are correct?

- a) I only
- b) II only
- c) Both I and II
- d) Neither I nor II

Ans) b

Exp) Option b is the correct answer.

Statement I is incorrect. SabhaSaar is an **Artificial Intelligence (AI)-powered tool to auto-generate gram sabha meeting minutes.**

The tool generates transcription from a video or audio, translates it into a chosen output language and prepares a summary. It creates structured minutes of meetings from the audio or video of Gram Sabha and other Panchayat gatherings. It is linked with Bhashini, the National Language Translation Mission, which allows it to currently work in 13 Indian languages

Recording the minutes is not one of the feature of SabhaSaar. It is simply an Artificial Intelligence (AI)-powered meeting summarization tool designed to automatically generate structured Minutes of Meeting (MoM) from Gram Sabha or other Panchayat meetings' audio and video recordings.

Statement II is correct. In August 2025, the **Ministry of Panchayati Raj launched SabhaSaar.**
