post world war II, when asked about the GDP figures' utility, the western economists elaborated • GDP can bring happiness to all, increased GDP can be a guarantee of beautiful poetry, poems,

gender equality, inequities, & obviously inclusivity. Influenced of this above notions about GDP, many newly decolonised economies pursued the targetting of GDP. They were, actually, betting on the 'tickle down' effect - gradual percolation of fruits of increased growth towards lower strata of society.

They were indeed wrong. As Amartya Sen, an economist from India, differentiated between growth & development. Growth is GDP's upward trajectory, & development is inclusive, equitable distribution of fruit of GDP.

Hence, above mentioned countries saw growth instead of development till 1980s. Am Sen, therefore, further popularised the concept of 'freedom'

& 'inclusive growth'. In today's economic & social paradigm this term - Inclusive is in ogue.

'Inclusive India' is concept of 'inclusive development' of our country.

Inclusive means to move together in the development story. It is concept of no one is left behind, it is Ak sen

freedom, indeed. Freedom means

every person will have equitable opportunities to fulfill her/his dreams, realize her potential & all rights guaranteed by the state. Also, inclusive means equal

say in the governance & participation of each member without undue fear & favour.

But this 'equal say' & participation will be futile, if we can't figure out

For whom 'inclusivity' we are talking about.
To whom, this equitable distribution of growth fruit we are going to deliver is crucial for realising Inclusive India.

Inclusive India : To whom

Inclusivity is needed because India is subcontinent in itself, holding diverse people, religions, civilisations, geographies, ecosystems & what not.
Therefore, deliberate intervention to redistribution to those who are left behind is actually, inclusivity.

women are prominent left behind :
Increased care work / unpaid work, gender violence, low pay, glass ceiling effect,

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patriarchy & many more erode their
development. Consider, ~~Sofia Kureishi~~, RG Kar
medical college rape in Kolkata, where we
were forced to say - Beti padhi par Beti Bachhi

nahi. Another group left behind is the
SC, ST & OBC. They are at lower rung,
thanks to their own way of life - life
is far away from mainstream. But, mining,
encroachment due to urbanisation, cultural
transgressions have left them behind. This
can be seen in Bastar & Dandakaranya
where they are struggling with sickle cell disease

Next are minorities, especially muslims.
Lynching, freedom of choice, gender & honor
majoritarianism etc are punishing them
& keeping at bay in development process.
To illustrate, despite courage & national service
(Sofia Kureishi (Colonel) faced religious
taunt by ministers from Madhya Pradesh).

Additionally, the LGBTQ, the PWDs & Elderly are facing the threat of exclusion from 'inclusive' concept. Ableism, ageism, hatred, agony, disdain from rest of the mainstream is normal.

• One can see supreme court judgement in Suryo Chakravarti, where LGBTQ denied marriage rights.

Further, the people from North East face threat of deprivation. They are financially dependent on central govt under Article 251; They are in conflict & in flux since independence. They face discriminatory remarks like Chinki. They are also often ignored by mainstream media. Consider Manipur & Kuki v/s Meitei conflict.

lastly, though refugees, slum dwellers, children are left behind, too, But we can't ignore the wildlife.

Hence, for the Biotic flora & fauna "Inchmare India" is 'Singular'. They are the trespassers in their 'own' land!

They are confined to few enclaved parks & sanctuaries & lean further these are encroached upon at their peril. Consider the Great Nicobars project, the Andamans, crocodile, leatherback turtle will face exclusion.

So, question is, what are the threats to inclusive development of above mentioned entities?

Firstly, Inequality in development. Post LPG reforms, emp development has been besided. Today, 120 billionaires have 1.6 Trn \$ out of 4 Trn \$ economy of India.

This crowd outs the fiscal space of government for inclusive growth. Consider, the meagre 70,000 crore (0.26% of GDP) expenditure on MNREGA.

Secondly, Majoritarianism? It

Is dominance of majority to care out
resources of it. Dominance prevails in
Culture, Finance, & power share. Consider
the recent allegation of Hindi Heartland
dominance over Marathi & Tamil.

This dominance is visible in
patriarchy, caste dominance, ~~the~~ urban
elite dominance, religious dominance &
what not. Consider the Reddy, the Yadav
to name a few. Their political power share
reduces scope of other castes. It's, although
not their fault at all.

Thirdly, catch all factors like
Colonial history & inequitable societal
heritage, rapid urbanisation, climate
change, cultural & religious sanctions.
To name a few. Consider, the heat wave
in west, it caused 45-50 death of
migrant laborers in Delhi due to stroke.

Therefore, we must have to be
clear about our 'inclusive' India & the
means to achieve it.

The first measure will be
the governance. All the four pillars will
have to work in unison. The parliament-
led statutes like maternity benefit Act,
POW Act, women reservation, wildlife Act
etc are welcome.

Judiciary led activism
to protect fundamental rights & deciding
the 'Carbon' (who benefits) of inclusive
growth should be continuous. Consider,
recent judgment in right against climate
change in Ranjit Singh case.

Bureaucracy must be humane
for effective inclusion of the left behind.
Their budgetary allocation, disaster management,
smoothing the faultlines & preempt them,
compassionate attitude, urban governance
are need of the hour.

Secondly, Collective Conscience of society. We as country as a whole had dream of 'inclusive India' in 'Mahore session' 1949, even before independence. Each one of us must reflect & take care of vulnerable nearby. As, Ambedkar said it is 'Conscience' which will be the basis of all rights, even fundamental rights.

Thirdly, CSO, NGO, media led participation to be an interface of powerful & powerless. Consider, the 'Jeevika didi' of Bihar or 'Kudumbashree' of Kerala.

~~For~~ Above these all, we need to think beyond inclusion to uplift the left behind. We can't ignore, therefore, the efficiency - It generate GDP & so richer class, a pie to share. A

Also, the rise of doing business might lose inclusion; as, MMC

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demands flexibility in labor rules of hire/fire.
 lastly, GDP matters too, we just can't focus on distribution & handholding.
 GDP is the pie which is to be distributed equitably. This pie must grow incessantly.

Concluding our discussion, we can say that failure of inclusive growth will attract chaos & conflict. Inclusive growth is sin-qua-non for this diversified & the largest democracy. We can easily detect have-nots who are devoid of resources, power share & agency. They can be given finance, power share & handholding.

Our country is not constituted of few elites, power holders, rich, dominants & people of specific geographies. It is, actually, the voice of women, tribes, wildlife, skn dwellers, minorities, deaths equally & in fact more vocally. The day their voices will be heeded, Ramsajye will usher in.



& decline of wise choices

What are smart devices? Devices

which mimics human cognition. By working
on algorithm, they try to reach near the
human's brain. To illustrate, computer,
satellites, drones, robots & devices in
cyber space like social media platform.
James, new, Artificial intelligence is
completely a substitute of human brain
(ushering in complete era of smart devices).

Coming to Wise Choices → the
choices made with pragmatism, thought process
, scientific temper ← logical reasoning.
To illustrate, 1600 century AD, the
Europeans expelled the yoke of churches
& accepted work as ethics & worship.

They thereby, wisely chose 'secularisation' of their life & resultantly became flagbearers of industrial growth & a superpower.

~~the~~ Smart devices & wise choices: former's rise, latter's decline

When we look at our market economy post LPA reforms & globally, post Washington Consensus — thesis of free & open economies, free trade etc, we see this evident. Smart economy based on IT & ITes like Computers, services, listing of shares on financial market etc, reduced our wise choices of inclusive growth. Currently, we have jobless growth further, smart devices like computers led to bubble of dot com in share market, later, we had financial crisis of 2008.

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similarity in our society, we talk of gender equality, several of patriarchy.

But instead of removing these, the smart devices are further aggravating these.

Consider the (meta maid), digital domestic maid in urban class, they perpetuate digital patriarchy. Our choices are funnelled

much or delegated task to smart devices to remove patriarchy.

Even in our personal life, the current-generation ~~is facing~~ Gen Z, is facing a dilemma of smart devices like AI &

wise choices like 'Critical thinking' based study

Smart bots like Grok, ChatGPT are eroding

their pedagogy based skills like summarising

~~article~~ article writing, complex scientific

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& mathematical solutions. This has been tagged by Oxford dictionary as brain-rot, where poor or simple content can erode our brain's critical thinking.

Also, when we talk of ideas any smart devices come in our ways. Consider the idea of degrowth to slow down our GDP growth & let heal the Earth. But, smart devices like solar sensitive batteries, Autonomous vehicles boost humans to pursue growth in new smart technologies!

Thanks to smart devices. That we are seeing lopsided urbanisation, & settlement in Himalayas beyond its carrying capacity. Smart ICS, smart GPS, & smart Geospatial management are compelling us to not to make sustainable development choice.

So, ~~the~~ it is clear that-

Smart devices are result of relentless human pursuit of technology & curiosity.
But, what led to fall in wise choices?

Multiple reasons are there.

Firstly, the smart devices themselves, as we discussed. They reduce efforts needed ^{from} humans, consider the critical thinking needed to allocate limited fiscal space in budget preparation. Accustomed to smart devices like computers, we may simulate the allocation. There is then threat of 'unwise choice' & biased allocation to undesired sectors.

Further, these devices increase the leisurely activities, consider e-governance & concept of minimum governance. Reducing personnel from governance may reduce 'Think tank' to form wise foreign policies. Choices like multi-alignments, inclusive growth, environment justice to name a few.

Secondly, smart devices indirectly obviate the need of functional literacy & so illiteracy prevails. This further reduces scientific temper & wise decisions. Concedes, the digital literacy, Alexa & Siri might reduce work burden but also reduce the need of functional literacy.

Thirdly, smart devices comes with their own challenges. Their countering require extra fund, so reduced scope of choice of expenditure over welfare. Concedes the expenditure on 'air defence system' to counter drones, expenditure on Cyber-space complex to prevent cyber attack.

Fourthly, other factors like increased income & reduced efforts toward research, notion of 'living' of his life, increased consumerism, materialism & many more. These factors reduce time for wise choices.

as wise choices require pragmatism & sustained efforts towards thinking the cost benefits. Considers, the care of freedom struggle for our country. Our forefathers thought for 50 years towards a democratic inclusive, liberal & just polity; They made wise choices

But we can't just set the dichotomy of smart devices & wise choices. & conclude. Their amalgamation can bring real intergenerational & intra-generational sustainability.

Wise choices are needed for sustainability of our economics. Smart devices like AI can help. Considers, NISAR satellite for monitoring our ecosystem. But we also need right resources for right choice of placing the resources require educated, skilled leaders & personnel. They must go for brainstorming in pedagogy

without ~~per~~ delegating the task to
smart devices.

Further inclusive growth needs
wise choices of finance, power &
attention share distribution. This requires
also, compassion, care, & helping hand
humane face, of which, so far, smart
devices are devoid of.

Also, military & national security
require wise choices along with smart
devices to have an edge in zero-
sum game with respect to our hostile
neighbours. Consider the wise choice of
Integrated Theatre Command (ITC) &
smart device of S-400 defence.

Lastly, climate change calls for
adaptation & mitigation — two wise
choices, but — like we saw Trump's
drill slogan, we are not fully choosing
them. They need transfer of

Smart technologies like EVs, solar cells & nuclear ~~to~~ reactors along with finance at CoP.

So, while concluding this, we can emphasize on the wise choices over smart devices. It has been wise choices that we chose to fund & develop smart choices, so wise choices are common denominator.

Humans persist towards curiosity & functional appreciation of technology is not new. But humans after ~~fire~~ discarding fire did not reduce the wise choice of moving to dwellings from open & then cooking hot meals.

Similarly, the development of AI needs large parameters of data & GPUS. There are accumulated data ~~of~~ of choices made by humans. To sustain the very evolution of

small devices, we need constant-wise choices.

wise choices over inclusivity, sustainability, climate justice, peaceful world, Complex research over disease, space, new technologies can never be substituted.

Wisdom is the long protected asset of humans, small devices must accentuate this instead of diminishing it. Wisdom is the lifebreak & ultimate sophistication of humanity. It is through wise choices we have reached close to utopia. It seems Utopian society require wise choices firstly & lastly, rest all factors must assist the wisdom.
