Data without wisdom and innovation without ethics are dangerous tools

Two different headlines of the newspaper as head are :

Headline 1 :

"CAMBRIDGE ANALYTICA SCAM : User data tracked and used to manipulate them"

Headline 2 :

"Horror in civilisation of Japan after Hiroshima, Nagasaki bombing continues even today"

The above two headings clearly state the relevance of the topic where the first headline talks about how irresponsible consumption of data on social media led to echo chamber formation and easy manipulation during US elections for party propaganda. This affected decisions of voting and effectiveness of democracy negatively. Thus data consumption without mindfulness & wisdom is dangerous.

Similarly second headline depicts how innovation of nuclear bombs by Openheimer and usage of it in World War II has left a lasting disastrous impact in Japan. Children still born with genetic diseases & issues due to nuclear impact. Thus innovations without ethical considerations have left huge danger for humanity!

The human society has evolved from agricultural society to a current modern

Industry 4.0 based society. Tools of progress today are measured in terms of innovation, cognitive capabilities, data access & processibility, technological advancement etc. These tools are used for global superiority, delivery of public services efficiently or boost to economic growth. For instance, data on space and innovations for human spaceflight program both help a ~~big~~ leap in mankind's progress.

But "Nothing vast comes into this world without a curse", as remarked by Sophocles. It is how we handle the curse that decides the destiny of a new advancement or tool. So data and innovation's effectiveness depends on how they are used and what fuels them.

Data without wisdom turns to be curse which is unhandled and same is case with innovation without ethics. How they dangerous tools? let's understand.

Data is the new oil and religion. But what makes it worth or adds value is wisdom to process the data for bringing data driven policy decisions. But lack of wisdom, makes data just like a rock which is simply kept as showpiece rather than using it to build something. For instance, data of weather patterns, climate is available but lack of applying this to implement climate based cropping system leads to agricultural failure.

Similarly, biased knowledge and opinionated approach leads to subjective understanding of data which is dangerous. For instance AI models having biased data against blacks, low caste as seen in recent case

of Gemini AI where black leaders like Desmond Tutu also brightened skin colour depiction. This ~~is~~ strengthens discrimination and structural hierarchy in society, which is dangerous for humanity.

Moreover, lack of righteous wisdom and approach to tackle data, threatens privacy of humans. For example, in usage of social media, internet for free, it is the large MNCs who are at advantage and using your data for capitalists needs. As rightly said "if you are not paying for the product, you are the product". So such private data tracking and selling by large companies leads to cyber security dangers and identity thefts.

Lack of wisdom in data collection is an added danger. Lack of training of enumerators limits effectiveness of data and leads to faulty policies. Like in case of caste census, ~~lack~~ due to multiplicity of castes and lack of knowledge of data enumerators of all, the data might not be completely

objective and whole

Wisdom also involves power to take step and act rightly based on data analysis.

But lack of such power to enforce the right also makes the data dangerous. For instance, use of money & muscle power in vote and election systems is known by data but lack of power to election commission makes it dangerous to protect democracy.

People lack wisdom these days due to rote learning basis of educational curriculum, lack of practicality to apply data and extract information out of it. Low skills of people for data analytics. Only 5% of people in demographic dividend are formally skilled in India as per India's skills report.

So, once these bottlenecks are addressed and wisdom is developed, it leads to innovation by using scientific research over data.

However, this innovation's implications depends on the intent and ethics behind it. If there is no ~~innovative~~ ethical values framework behind innovative steps it leads to do more harm than good. For instance genetic engineering to change genes of babies to produce beautiful, flawless - designer babies harms the natural human reproductive process and goes against nature.

If innovation is to mark a status and show one's prowess, or to threaten other's position, it only leads to animosity and unethical competition. For instance, nuclear enrichment and proliferation race worldwide to maintain nuclear power.

As Gandhiji adds "Science without humanity" as a sin. It clearly depicts how innovations purely for economic growth by man without responsibility threatens the position of man itself. M. Shelley in her "Frankenstein" clearly explained how

AI, robotics would take over man, displace them, control them, alienate them and dehumanise the society. Thus innovation without ethics can threaten humans itself. This has been depicted in Robot movie of Rajnikant

Innovation without compassion for humans, empathy can turn materialistic and end lives. For instance, Roubaroxy drug with not successful clinical trials was still introduced, threatening lives of people.

Innovations through industrialisation, setting up manufacturing units, leads to displacement of tribes, vulnerable without adequate rehabilitation and compensation. This further marginalises them and is dangerous for their livelihood.

Moreover, introduction of GM crops, GM trees etc without checking long term impact on humans and environment

and only focus on increasing crop yields also leads to deteriorating environment sustainability.

Such innovations of today lacks ethics due to fickle mindsets and moral vacuum of people whose target is only to earn, who lacks to ~~see~~ have far-sightedness. Innovation also lacks ethics as people who innovate wants to showoff what great minds they are and what they could create. For example use of Deep Fakes for cyber frauds

However, at times despite right ethical innovation brought, it is the way the innovation used which makes it dangerous. So the intent of usage of innovation equally important and not only while making the innovation. For instance, Deep and dark web ~~usage~~ intent for making was for private security intelligence sharing but its usage by terrorist organisation for organised crimes has reduced it to dangerous one!

Similarly, at times serendipity helps in data encounters and analysis. And this along with wisdom can help bring and do great wonders in society. This extends from ISRO's data on other countries lunar mission and using it by further adding cost-efficient wisdom to achieve success; to making data driven policies like DBT, PDS etc. to uplift poor and backward.

On the other hand innovation with ethics also ensures 'Ubuntu' - Welfare of all Humanity. This can be depicted in case of Ethical Hacking, innovating green technologies for sustainability, to being social justice. Ethics are basic needs for innovation to actual make & being positive change in society.

So to see the light and move beyond the dangers, inculcation of wisdom and ethics is needed. As data and innovation steps are being taken by all

Nations in the race. What will stand out is those who imbibe wisdom and ethics in this process.

Wisdom is polished as it continuously evolves with times. This can be done by participating in argumentative dialogues through Samajik Chetna Kendras, by learning from experiences, reading biographies of leaders and their life. This brings rationality and better knowledgability to comprehend data better.

This wisdom will also build ethics, to take responsibility of every innovation. Ethics will ensure to lighten and progress the darkness of society by right innovations and remove or discard any unethical thought ~~for~~ of innovation for ulterior purpose.

Just like camphor spreads its fragrance even when being burnt, ethics

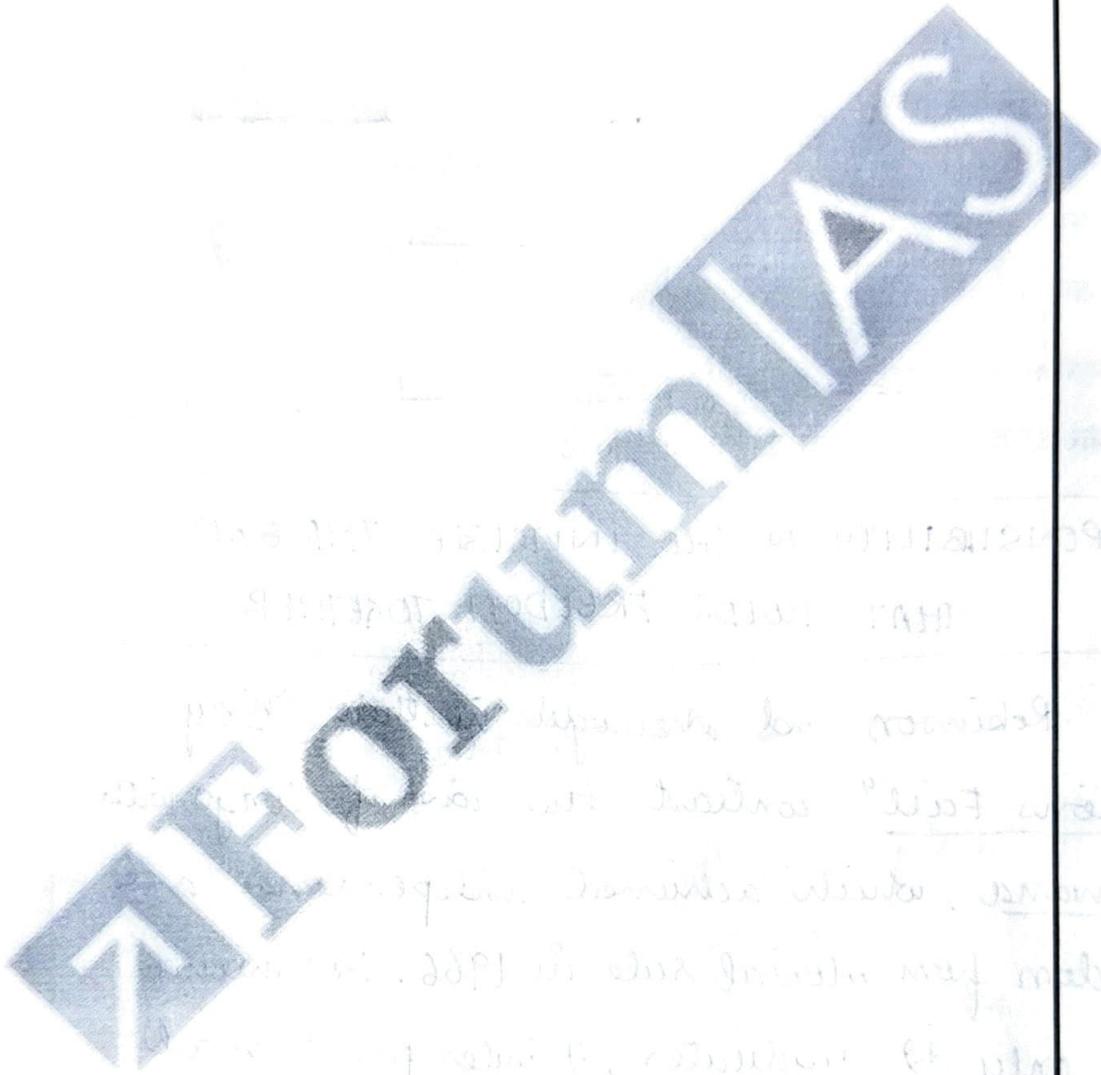

RESPONSIBILITY IS THE INVISIBLE THREAD
THAT HOLDS FREEDOM TOGETHER

Robinson and Senoqun in their "Why Nations Fail", contrast the case of Congo with Botswana, which achieved independence and freedom from colonial rule in 1966. Botswana had only 2 graduates, 7 miles paved road and white supremacist rule all along its neighbors.

Botswana adopted a rule which conducted regular elections, gave enhanced property rights to people and freedom to speech, expression and did not have any civil war ever. When diamonds were

discovered, the farsighted law used them for national good rather than elite gain. It chose democracy over dictatorship and public interest and people centric responsibility rather than private elite gain. A

All this led Botswana to be highest per capita income based country in Saharan region, where state's responsibility towards freedom of people, to provide them rights, to give conducive environment for growth led to cherishing the independence it gained! This clearly depicts how responsibility acts as threads to hold freedom together.

Humans have evolved from primitive stages where he/she was free to do whatever one liked, but the responsibility for Man-Animal balance and Nature kept their freedom in check and held all humans to respect nature. They maintained their responsibility which in fact enhanced

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their freedom to move and enjoy benefits of forests - fruits, fodder, shade etc.

With the progress of mankind, man has been vying for freedom to take own decisions, of speech, expression, of living in their own way, of movement etc. This liberty or freedom according to one's own will can cause depression, chaos, conflicts or can be to exercise rights. So what keeps freedom intact for a larger purpose is the 'thread of Responsibility'

As in case of Gandhiji's withdrawal of Non-cooperation movement, it was because of Gandhiji's responsibility to protect all people and conduct peaceful protests which was violated due to Chauri-Chaura incident. By taking up responsibility, freedom of people was maintained.

So, why and how does this thread of responsibility hold freedom together?

It is said that "Duty and Freedom are two sides of the same coin". So responsibility is embedded along with freedom. Ashoka, realised this and propogate 'Dharma', as a responsibility of each individual to follow it. As Dharma bondeness → could only lead to freedom and salvation of individuals in actual sense.

Responsibility is that thread that stitches and binds all humanity into one. It leads to solidarity based on Sarvodaya principle and values of empathy and compassion. In times of COVID-19 where world was moving towards Vaccine Nationalism, India's Vaccine Maitri initiative for global citizens, helped keep the freedom of people to live even today!

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Responsibility comes with accountability, answerability and transparency to people, so that the freedom they achieved is well maintained and valued even today. TN Seshan, an IAS officer, brought election reforms by introducing disclosures of criminal cases, incomes, qualifications of politicians to people before elections. This political responsibility enhances their freedom to choose right candidate.

Not only this, the very constitutional morals of equality, non-discrimination, welfarism for poverty alleviation and social justice protects the freedom & liberty of all sections of society. The responsibility of state and the citizens towards each other maintain liberty of all. To perform these tasks, schemes like Aashirwad Kalyan Yojana, JAM trinity, Direct Benefit Transfer, subsidisation are responsibilities of nation to protect freedom of vulnerable sections.

Responsibility makes sure that freedom is knit with right methods. It ensures equity and equal participation based on their impact and actions. For instance, Common But Differentiated Responsibilities of nations towards climate finance & mitigation helps protect freedom of Small Island nations and developing nations.

Additionally it is said a Responsible leader is a leader who ensures free ideas, freedom of people to mobilise themselves. Leadership responsibility keeps all masses together making a single fabric from thread to celebrate their freedom. Lal Bahadur Shastri's responsible step to take Green Revolution helped achieve freedom from foreign imports and dependency of agriculture and Indian farmers.

This responsibility transgresses into various sectors where corporate social responsibility maintains ~~corpo~~ freedom

of people by socially motivated steps for upliftment of marginalised. Microsoft's activities for tribal education, skilling in Amazon forests to give them freedom from primitiveness.

This responsibility is a touchstone to self as well as it makes us hold our freedom in way that is for betterment of others and not harming other's rights to achieve our freedom. Responsible self makes sure to not radicalise people or not to involve in criminal activities just because social media provides freedom/anonymity. It guides to protect freedom of all for progress through social media.

But ^{some} people today lack responsible values, don't focus on freedom of others. Why so? One of the reasons is that, their thread of responsibility is weak and breaks in times of test. Moral corruption by

ideals of greed, capitalism, selfish interests for one's own gain reduces responsible attitude and usurps freedom of others. For instance, China's debt trap policy reduces nations to pawns in hands of China, restricting their freedom.

Freedom also takes a backseat, when responsibility is lost in competition of power. Lone for power, has made humans just as means for the ends of powerfulness. In recent war scenarios, human right violations, internet ban has reduced freedom to mere waste, as no nation being a responsible one!

Not only this, loss of responsibilities ~~is~~ in bureaucracy through corruption, in corporates through wokisim, in media through Fake news and Yellow journalism has only put freedom of people at risk. As people are now controlled by such irresponsible leaders who only see their

own needs. So all this definitely calls for responsibility to be sown, as seeds to gain ~~the~~ and make thread of it. But responsibility also restricts freedom at times.

Too much responsibility restricts man to redundant tasks done daily in a routine. It reduces risk taking ability and reduces human to a "Marginal and Burdened person". For instance, Mother's responsibility towards child, household work, elders, reduces her freedom to participate in economic opportunities. Not only mother but youth due to increased responsibility to feed family and its needs, leads to their freedom restricted due to societal pressures.

So all this makes one thing clear, it is not the man who is intelligent,

not the man who is physically strong, but the man who is responsible who can exercise freedom in its true sense! It is necessary to inculcate responsible values to protect freedom of self and others. This can be done by inculcating Constitutional morals, by narrating the struggles of national leaders who fought for our freedom and to act responsibly to protect it.

So, responsibility as a thread is not an all encompassing thread made up of various facets of social, political, economic, environmental responsibility to hold freedom of individual, society, nation and world altogether.

This thread of responsibility should be flexible and not tightly held so that it restricts freedom. It should be adapted and adjusted so that freedom in true

sense is felt. Right pull of thread is needed in case freedom is taken away.

For instance, social and responsible behaviour enforcement by SBBI through ESG norms on major companies to protect freedom of small & vulnerable sections:

Thus freedom and responsibilities are two ends connected by a thread and needs to be strengthened. It is usually said - "We cannot change India". But Gandhiji did it by taking responsibility. Similarly, we should stand and be responsible to take India out of poverty, inequality, casteism, gender divide and bring the new freedom!
