

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

Characteristic having crucial role

- ③ Moderates Internal heat seen during pre-monsoon season
- ④ Seasonal reversal of winds ensure fertilisation of plains & plantation crop.

⑤ Replenishes Alluvial soil due to overflow of rivers and wet lands.

⑥ Determines timing of sowing of crops → Paddy in Punjab is only sown once monsoon rains.

Challenges

→ Erratic and Unreliable monsoon.

→ ~~Low~~ Extreme rainfall event leading to crop loss.

→ Low productivity of rainfall agriculture.

Monsoon thus has multidimensional impact on Indian agriculture.

Thus Emergency made Indian democracy strong & people aware of their responsibilities.

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


Q.13) What are 'atmospheric rivers'? How do they influence global weather patterns and impact human settlements? (15 marks, 250 words)

Atmospheric rivers are moisture laden air circulation leading to heavy precipitation in some areas of world.



## Effect on global weather pattern

- ① lead to change in local weather (eg) → precipitation in Atacama desert.
- ② It leads to cooling of climate due to evap precipitation.
- ③ Role in water cycle, may recharge dried up ecosystem (eg) → dry Californian forests.
- ④ Disturb water circulation from part of earth to other.
- ⑤ Effect on cyclones, may feed & intensify cyclones.

Impact human settlement

- ① Heavy precipitation, may cause flash flood.
- ② leads to rainfall in water deficit area.
- ③ Moderating influence on local climate → less chances of heatwaves & strokes.
- ④ Cause loss to agricultural produce and dairy animal.

Thus need to study and ~~atmospheric~~ research phenomena to better understand consequence and predict incoming.


Q.14) Despite sharing a similar latitude, why does the Mediterranean climate vary from the China-type climate? How do the differences in climate affect life and economic activities in the region?

Mediterranean and China type climate lie between subtropical high pressure and temperate low pressure belt but varied climate. Latitude (40-50)



Reason for different climate

- ① During summer winds in mediter are offshore leading dry winds  
↳ Apparent north movement of ITCZ leads to shifting of belts

② During Winter → downward shift of belt brings westerly from atlantic with moister in mediterranean.

However on west of China lies continent thus no chance of wind bearing winds.



### Affect on life

① Dry intense heat during summer in mediterranean, pseudo-monsoon type rain during mid/late summer.

② Rain in winter leads to moderate winter, intense cold winter with winds from seberia.

Affect on Economic activities

- ① Unique agriculture produce  
 (Eg) → Olives, tomatoes, oranges, (orchids)
- ② Promotes tourism from western Europe. &
- ③ Brings rainfall for agriculture, particularly rice farming in China.

Thus unique continent - oceanic & wind interface generate different climate.

Q.15) "The tropical Indian Ocean is likely to be in a near-permanent heatwave state." Discuss the factors responsible for the rapid warming of the Indian Ocean along with its multi-dimensional impacts. (15 marks, 250 words)

According to IMD, Indian Ocean has warmed  $0.7^{\circ}\text{C}$  on average from pre-industrial times.

Factors responsible for rapid warming

- ① Global warming due to climate change, ocean absorbs more than 70% of  $\text{GHG}$  emission.
- ② Changed deep ocean circulation, leading to reduced flows of cold water.
- ③ Warming during Positive Indian Ocean Dipole.
- ④ Effect of El-Niño Southern Oscillation.

- ⑤ Decreased river waterflow due to human use → Damming & diversion
- ⑥ Closed nature of ocean leads to less water circulation.
- ⑦ Higher contact with land mass relative to other ocean, conducts heating

### Multi-Dimensional Impact

- ① Sea level rise intensification  
↳ higher temp leads to thermal expansion of water.
- ② Disturb fish leading to threat to fisherman livelihood threat.

- ③ Bleaching of coral reefs → 90% projected to disappear by 2070.
- ④ Heatwave in coastal towns → crosses 1/5th of population.
- ⑤ Increased incidence of tropical cyclone (Eg) → more cyclone in arbian sea ~~data~~ in recent years.
- ⑥ Effect on Indian monsoon → more erratic and unpredictable.

Hence warming not only threat to nature but humans as well, need for global climate action inline with Paris Agreement.

→ Kerala  $\rightarrow$  20%

Impact on region economic growth

① Reduced labour availability, leading to non-competitive industry

- ② Low demand generation → youth  
& have more prosperity to consume.
- ③ Greater importance to silver  
economy → elderly care  
infrastructure.
- ④ Reduced fiscal transfer under  
finance commission → as population  
is criteria.

### Impact on social welfare policies

- ① Greater spend on healthcare,  
strain on public hospital.
- ② Need of social safety nets  
pension.
- ③ Increased tax burden on  
youth.

④ Call for more basis by politician to handle issue of low TFR.

Extreme rainfall & flash flood leading to devastaty consequences

① Cloud Burst in hilly cities leading to destruction of property

(Eg) → Ladakh in 2017

② Tropical cyclone leading to rain and storm surge.

(Eg) → Cyclone kutke in Gujarat

③ Climate Change caused extreme event → 5 times more likely of extreme rain





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
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
