**There are no changes to the solutions/answers. Explanations have been provided for the students who have raised doubts.**

**Q.37)** A doubt was raised whether the INA flag was first hoisted on Indian soil in Moirang, Manipur.

**Exp)** **It was on April 14, 1944, that the flag of the INA was hoisted for the first time on Indian soil at Moirang.** The question is in the context of the Indian National Army (INA) or Azad Hind Fauz under which on April 14, 1944, Colonel Shaukat Ali Malik hoisted the flag of the provincial government in Moirang. The INA flag comprises yellow, white and green. The image of a springing tiger was in the middle of the flag.

While Subhash Chandra Bose, as Head of the State of the Provisional Government of Azad Hind hoisted the Tricolour on 30th December 1943 in Andaman and Nicobar Islands, declaring the Islands as the first Indian Territory to be freed from colonial rule.

The Statement in the question is specific to the activities of INA. Earlier, as well, the tricolour flag had been hoisted, but in Moirang, Manipur, it was the first time the INA flag was hoisted
